Summer Curriculum Overview

Communication and Language

- Enhance and develop new vocabulary
- Listen with sustained concentration
- Respond appropriately, including asking questions
- Opportunities for chat and back and forth conversation in play e.g role play, games, purposeful play
- Tales Toolkit – continued awareness of storytelling; children working independently

Literacy

- Opportunities for mark making/ writing as part of continuous provision
- Encourage independent writing
- Stories –discuss setting, characters, story structure, key events
- Information books – how to use a contents page to find the information
- Phonics- taught through Little Wandle Letters and sounds revised. Handwriting is included

Understanding the World

- Understand what a life cycle is
- Discuss how plants/ animals grow and change
- Develop knowledge of habitats – link to 'Where in the World'
- Learn about pollution
- Develop understanding of past and present – link to seaside

Physical Development

- Develop gross motor skills through use of the outdoor area and in PE lessons.
- Throw and catch a ball/beanbag
- Strike a target
- Begin to develop speed when running

- Understand regular exercise can keep you healthy and discuss importance of sleep

Mathmatics

- Subitising numbers to 5/ 10
- Finding reliable ways to count large groups of objects
- Knows composition of numbers to 10
- Know doubles/ halves to 10
- Have an understanding of odd and even numbers
- Subtracting within 10
- Recognising when quantities are more/less than 10

Expressive Art and Design

- Free paint and collage
- Share creations and explain what they have done
- Singing songs and Nursery rhymes
- Free dancing / instruments
- Class music lessons – playing different instruments/ body percussion, learning rhythms, pitch
