### Communication and Language

- Listen carefully and respond appropriately

- Asking questions- who, what, where
- Tales Toolkit – developing awareness of story telling

### Mathematics

- Careful counting
- Subitising
- Recognising numbers up to 5
- Partitioning numbers- using vocab part and whole
- Using language more, fewer and equal
- Finding 1 more than a given number

- Singing number rhymes

### Understanding the World

- Discussion about ourselves and our families
- Learning about similarities and differences – painting self portraits
- Finding out about jobs
- Exploring changes in our environment – Autumn and Winter
- Find out about animal habitats, hibernation, nocturnal animals

### Physical Development

- Develop gross motor skills through use of the outdoor area and in PE lessons.
- Introduce safe use of the climbing frame
- Practice fine motor skills – use of tweezers, pegs, threading
- Introduce dough disco
- Pencil grip – drawing ourselves, drawing different types of lines –'Get Squiggling'
- Effective use of scissors – from snips to cutting around complex shapes

### Expressive Art and Design

- Free paint and collage
- Learn new techniques – how to use watercolors, make box models
- Paint portraits
- Use clay to make hedgehogs
- Singing songs and Nursery rhymes
- Free dancing / instruments outside
- Class music lessons – playing different instruments, learning rhythms
