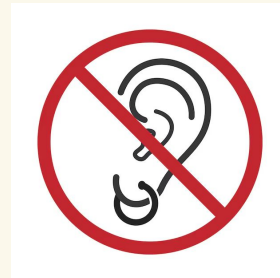
- Please name all uniform.

We are limited for space and the pegs for coats are positioned close together. Therefore large rucksacks are an unnecessary hazard.



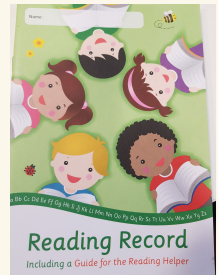
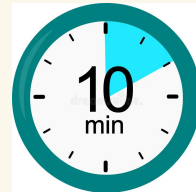

# Opal - muddy days
