Reading Books



Children will be read with by an adult regularly at school. We will change their books when they have finished reading their book.

We encourage the children to read at home 5 times a week. This can be to anyone! Mum, Dad, Sister, Brother, Auntie, Uncle, Grandparent - anyone who enjoys a good story!

Please sign your child's reading record after reading with them at home. It only needs to be 5-10 minutes if you're short for time - every little helps when reading.

We do check these regularly with classes having rewards for reading at home.

Uniform

Uniform



- It is also very helpful if all items of uniform are named, so if pieces of clothing are left outside/lost they can be reunited with their owner as quickly as possible.
- Winter uniform begins in the second half of Autumn term. For the juniors this means that shirts and ties are to be worn, not polo shirts.
- Please remember to send in a coat as the weather turns colder and wetter, as we will be out in all weathers.

P.E.

P.E. Lessons will be on a **Monday** (outside) and **Tuesday** (inside). Please send your child to school wearing their P.E kit.

P.E kit: yellow t-shirt, blue shorts, blue/black/grey tracksuit bottoms, blue sweatshirt/school jumper and trainers.

Hair must be tied back and earrings must be removed on a P.E. day.



Book bags

We are limited for space and the pegs for coats are positioned close together. Therefore large rucksacks are an unnecessary hazard. Book bags are preferable but if your child wants to bring a rucksack in, please ensure it is on the smaller side.

Pencil cases are not required in school as we provide stationery for the children. However, if they wish to bring in a small pencil case, which can fit into their trays, they may.



Home Learning

A home learning menu will be sent home with a range of activities. Each week the children are to pick one of the activities, complete it and bring it into school.

The children are expected to spend 10 minutes on times table rockstars 5 times a week and spelling shed once a week.

The children are also expected to read at least 5 times a week but preferably daily and have their reading record signed by an adult. Reading records will be checked daily.

Homework

- Maths - Daily Times Table Rockstars (5 times a week)
- Topic - this will be set on a Friday and due in on Monday
- Reading - 5 times a week

After Christmas, we will be sending home additional homework from SATs revision guides.
