Week beginning 22nd September 2025

This week we are continuing our work on The Colour Monster. We will be discussing our feelings and what we can do if we feel sad, lonely, angry etc. We will talk about our class rules and how to be kind and caring towards our friends.

Maths- This week in maths we will learning how to subitise - recognising how many objects in a group without actually counting them.

Phonics- We will be learning our first 4 new sounds:



s- as in snake



a- as in astronaut



t- as in tiger



p- as in penguin

Please support your child to learn these sounds, and practise writing the letters (lower case).

Remember to come along to the Phonics Workshop on Monday 29th September at 8.50am to find out how we teach phonics in school.

Please make sure your child comes to school with a coat everyday - named please. The weather is very changeable. Also make sure jumpers are named - a few have got lost already.

We hope you have been enjoying sharing library book at home. Reading lots of stories is a really important part of your child's literacy development. Library books need to be returned on a Friday. We hand out new books on a Friday.
