Week beginning 13/10

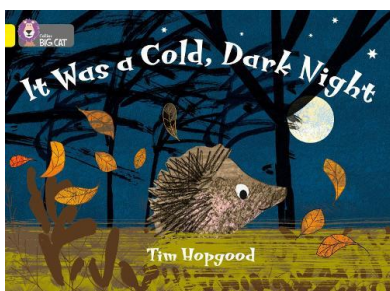
