

The Week Ahead....

Week beginning 13th October 2025

Thank you for all the baby photos. It's not too late if you haven't yet sent one in - the children love sharing them with their friends!

This week we will be looking at baby photos of the children and talking about how they have changed and grown. We will also talk about how to look after a baby and will have lots of opportunities for baby role play. We will think about what we might want to be when we grow up. Next week we will be talking about different jobs - if you are able to send in a photo of you wearing your work uniform or would like to tell us about your job we would be very grateful.

Maths This week, the children will build on their subitising skills. They will continue to use instant recognition - by saying the number of sounds that they can hear, such as claps or drum beats, without needing to count. They will be encouraged to look closely at small quantities and observe whether the quantity has changed or only the arrangement. When investigating the shapes made by Numberblock Four and making similar arrangements, children will continue to develop their skills of 'conceptual' subitising eg they will see that Numberblock Four can be arranged with 2 blocks on top of another 2 blocks or as a line of 3 with 1 on top, and connect both to 4.

Phonics- We will be learning 4 new sounds - ck e u r (see separate sheet)

Our tricky word is: I (recap is)

We will recap the last few week's sounds s a t p i n m d g o c k

Please support your child to learn these sounds. Please practise writing the letters using the rhymes on the alphabet sheet, and say the rhyme as you write.

We are enjoying making things using the junk modelling boxes. If you have any empty boxes such as cereal packets, biscuit boxes, kitchen roll middles etc we would be very grateful. We cannot accept boxes which have contained nuts. Thank you.
