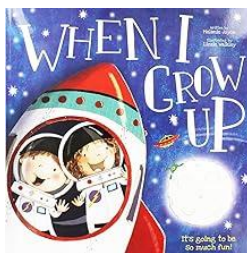


The Week Ahead....

Week beginning 20th October 2025



Topic

The children have been talking about what they want to be when they grow up, this week we will be looking at different jobs. The jobs suggested by the children have been varied, and included firefighters, hairdressers, doctors, teachers, bus drivers, police officers, builders and more. We have set up lots of role play activities and plan to extend the children's vocabulary, as well as developing their communication and language skills.

We will also be celebrating Diwali, and will be making divas, rangoli patterns and listening to the story about Rama and Sita.

At the end of the week we will be exploring pumpkins.

Maths

The comparison of quantities is something that children begin to do as babies. The activities this week will focus on developing this skill as children are encouraged to look carefully and use the language of comparison to describe sets of objects that they can see. Language is a key focus and adults will model the language of 'more than' and 'fewer than' to describe how many objects there are in each set. 'Fewer than' is used rather than 'less than' because the focus is on countable things.
