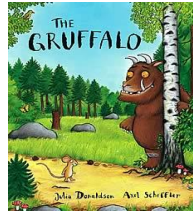


The Week Ahead....

This week we will be reading 'The Gruffalo' by Julia Donaldson. We will be retelling the story, discussing the beginning, middle and end. We will be acting out the story and learning how to make a story map. We will take part in big map activities outside, making a map of the Gruffalo's woodland. We will begin to find out facts about woodland animals.

We will also be learning about Remembrance Day.

Maths

This week, the children will continue to understand the purpose of counting - to find out 'how many' objects there are altogether. They will reinforce their understanding of cardinality - that the last number in the count tells us 'how many' things there are altogether in a set of objects - and they will practise their 1:1 correspondence skill, by counting numbers at the same time as moving or tagging objects. They will develop their understanding of 5 as a quantity by linking the number to the 5 fingers on one hand. The children will also begin to explore ways to represent numbers to 5 using their fingers and will understand the 'fiveness' of 5.
