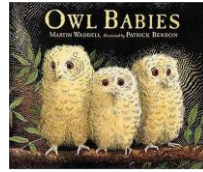


The Week Ahead....

The children will receive their first reading book this week. Please read with your child as many times as you can - practise at home makes a huge difference to children's progress. Please make a comment in the Reading Record. Reading books and library books **MUST** be returned on the Friday, in order for us to be able to give your child a new book.

Maths

We will be comparing quantities this week. When comparing, children notice attributes and begin to understand similarities and differences. The children will be encouraged to compare the number of objects in 2 sets by matching them 1:1. Seeing that objects in some sets can be matched without any being left over will help the children to understand when the quantities of objects are equal. Language is a key focus and the children will use the language of 'more than', 'fewer than' and 'an equal number' to describe how many objects there are in each set. 'Fewer than' is used rather than 'less than' and 'more than' is used rather than 'greater than'.

The children are enjoying practising songs for our Christmas Show. We will send home their parts and the costumes they will need at the end of the week.
