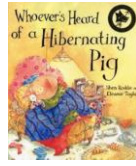


# The Week Ahead...

This week we will continue with our theme about woodland animals. We will find out about animals that hibernate and will read the story 'Whoever's heard of a hibernating pig', and 'Don't hog the hedge'. We will find out facts about hedgehogs and make our own hedgehogs out of clay.

## Phonics

This week we be learning these new sounds:

z- as in zebra          qu as in queen          ch as in cherries

We will add 's' to the end of words - plurals of words eg cats and verbs eg naps

We have some new tricky words:          go          no          to          into

## Maths

This week, the children will begin to explore **composition** by focusing on the first skills: the concept of 'wholes' and 'parts'. By investigating their own bodies and familiar toys they will begin to understand that whole things are often made up of smaller parts and that a whole is, therefore, bigger than its parts.
