Phonics

This week we will be learning about words with 's' added at the end (hats sits). Also, words ending 's' which make a z sound (his) and with 's' added at the end (bags), also making a 'z' sound.

Maths

This week, the children will continue to discover the purpose of counting - to find out 'how many' objects there are. The children will revisit the concept of 1:1 correspondence by making sure that they match collections of objects to their representations. They will develop their understanding of the concept of cardinality - that the last number in the count tells us 'how many' things there are altogether - and begin to apply this concept to count more abstract things, such as claps and jumps.
