Welcome back! We hope you have had a restful holiday.

The children are settling back into Nursery well.

We are currently having a two-week topic learning all about Winter. The cold weather and snow have allowed us to explore what happens to water when it gets very cold. The children loved sledging down the small hill on trays or bags, it was scary at first but they took a small risk and were laughing so much at the end. We have planted an amaryllis inside and are going to watch how it changes over time. The bulbs we planted inside at the end of term have started to emerge.



We have also explored repeating patterns which is one element of maths which is very important in the foundation of learning. The children made repeating patterns using cotton reels - they will be painting repeating pattern stripy scarves next week.

We will continue learning about winter and cold weather this week, learning the difference between summer and winter.

We have started sending home books and maths games again this week, please make sure your child had a bag big enough to bring them home safely - and could you also check all the pieces are back in the maths games before they come back to school. Thank you.

Can you make sure clothing and water bottles are named - we had three pairs of blue gloves this week, one pair is yet to be claimed.
