

# The Week Ahead....

Week beginning 2nd March 2026



This week we will continue to work on the story 'Supertato'. We will finish making our own Supertato - it is not too late to send in a medium sized (uncooked) baking potato for your child to use.

We will be celebrating World Book Day on Thursday - the children can come to school wearing pyjamas, but still need to wear sensible footwear.

On Friday, the children can wear their own clothes as we are having a 'Supertato fun day'. They can wear a superhero costume but if you do not have a superhero costume please don't worry, the children can make accessories at school.

## Phonics

This week we be recapping these phonemes: er air and double letters eg ss- hiss, tt - butter  
We practise reading words containing the digraph / trigraph- the children are encouraged to spot the digraph before reading the word.

We will read words containing double letters, and longer words. Remember when you read longer words you can 'chunk' them eg longer - long/er - read long then add er.

There are no new tricky words- but please continue to practise reading the tricky words. The children are now learning to write the tricky words.

## Maths

Through games and practical activities, the children will begin to develop their own 'mental number line', as well as the ability to understand which number is more than or less than another. When the children have a secure understanding of how to compare quantities, they will be able to order amounts in Key Stage 1 more easily. An understanding of comparison will also help to develop estimating skills by allowing the children to compare what they already know about quantity to an unknown amount.

Considering equal quantities and equal distribution will prepare the children for the meaning of the equals (=) symbol when it is introduced in Year 1.
