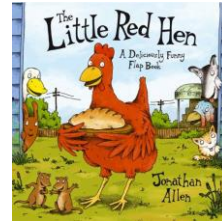
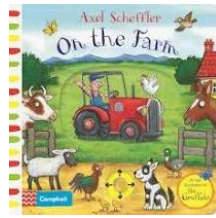


The Week Ahead...

Week beginning 9.3.2026



This week we will be reading lots of stories about farms. We will be learning about farms, and the animals that live on them in preparation for our trip on Thursday 19th March to Godstone Farm.

We will also be reading 'The Little Red Hen'. We will practise retelling the whole story with actions, focusing on the repeated refrains. See if your child can act out the story at the end of the week! We plan to make bread and then taste it with butter and jam.

Phonics

This week we be recapping our phonemes, and will be focusing on reading longer words eg market, finger, garden - remember you can chunk these words up eg mar / ket - you can sound out each part and then put it back together. We will read words ending with 'ing' eg looking, marching. We will revisit the compound words - 2 words that you can put together to make a new word eg car and park -carpark, sun and set - sunset.

Keep practising the tricky words - we are learning to write them as well as read them.

Maths

This week the children will be continuing to develop their understanding of the composition of numbers. They will continue their work on part- part whole eg 7 can be made up of 5 and 2; and understanding a whole number is made up of smaller parts.
