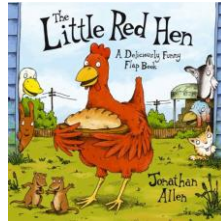


The Week Ahead...

Week beginning 16.3.2026



Last week the children really enjoyed learning 'The Little Red Hen' story and acting it out. See if your child can act it out at home. This week we will continue with this and learn about the life cycle of a hen. We will be learning about farms in preparation for our trip.

Phonics

This week we be focusing on reading longer words eg market, finger, garden - remember you can chunk these words up eg mar / ket - you can sound out each part and then put it back together. We will read words ending with 'ing' eg looking, marching, waiting. We will also revisit the compound words - 2 words that you can put together to make a new word eg car and park -carpark, sun and set - sunset.

Keep practising the tricky words - we are learning to write them as well as read them.

Maths

This week, the children will continue to develop their visualising skills by looking carefully at arrangements of dots and then closing their eyes to explain what they 'see'. The children will use their perceptual subitising skills (seeing the quantity without counting) to build on their understanding of equal amounts, and they will investigate equal groups. They will use dice patterns and numbers of fingers to explore doubling quantities to 10 eg double 2 is 4.
