

The week ahead

Monday 11th May 2026



Topic

Following on from our work on *The Very Hungry Caterpillar*, this week we will be learning about lots of different minibeasts. We will find out facts and make our own minibeast using natural materials and our craft resources. We will go on a minibeast hunt to see which creatures we can find in the playground.

Maths

This week's activities will focus on the ordinality of numbers: considering where numbers to 10 are in relation to each other. Through practical activities and games, the children will reason about numbers and think carefully about which is more or less. They will use linear number tracks to play games that encourage them to compare numbers that are far apart, near and next to each other. (For example, 10 is a lot more than 2 but 5 is only 1 more than 4.) We will roll dice and play track games, moving our counters along the track and making predictions about how many we need to land on a specified number.

Phonics

We will continue to consolidate the digraphs and trigraphs previously learned.

This week we will be assessing the children on the phonics we have learned this term.

Please continue to practise the tricky words from this term and encourage the children with their writing at home.
