

The week ahead

Monday 8th June 2026



Topic

This week we will continue to learn about animals that live in the jungle, and find out facts about them. We will use vocabulary such as endangered, camouflage, predator and habitat. We will be looking at Rousseau's painting 'Tiger in a tropical storm' and discussing how it would feel to visit the jungle.

Phonics

This week we are recapping on the digraphs we have learned previously.

We continue to practise writing sentences using some of the words. We are encouraging the children to write independently. This involves:

- Saying your sentence out loud before you start writing
- Sound talking each word as you write it
- Re-read what you have written to check it makes sense

Please help your child at home.

Maths

The children will be revising these skills:

- tagging each object in a group of up to 10 objects (1-to-1 correspondence)
- knowing number names to 10 and their order (stable order principle)
- knowing that the last number counted gives the total in the set (cardinal principle)
- counting up to 10 things that can't be seen or tagged, such as jumps, hops, sounds, etc. (abstraction principle)
- understanding that the quantity remains the same when (up to 10) objects are counted in a different order (order irrelevance principle)
- developing strategies to keep track of what has and has not been counted (e.g. rearranging objects into a line, moving objects as they're counted)
- recognising the pattern of the counting system, when beginning to count beyond 20.
