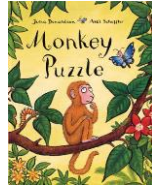


The Week Ahead....

Week beginning 1st June 2026

Welcome back after the holidays.



This week we will be reading *Monkey Puzzle* by Julia Donaldson. We will be learning about jungles and the animals that live there. We will find out where there are jungles in the world, and why they are endangered.

Phonics

This week we are recapping on the digraphs we have learned previously.

ai - tail in the rain; ee- sheep in the jeep; igh - light in the night; oa - soap that goat; oo- as in moon; oo -as in book; ar- as in dark; or- as in horn

We will be practising writing sentences using some of the words. We are encouraging the children to write independently. This involves:

- Saying your sentence out loud before you start writing
- Sound talking each word as you write it
- Re-read what you have written to check it makes sense

Maths

The children will practise their subitising skills (seeing the quantity without counting). We will also recap odd and even numbers, and finding 1 more or 1 less than a given number.

We will also be practising our number formation.
