Week beginning 22/6/26

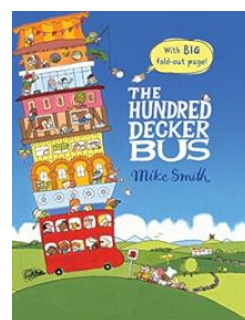
