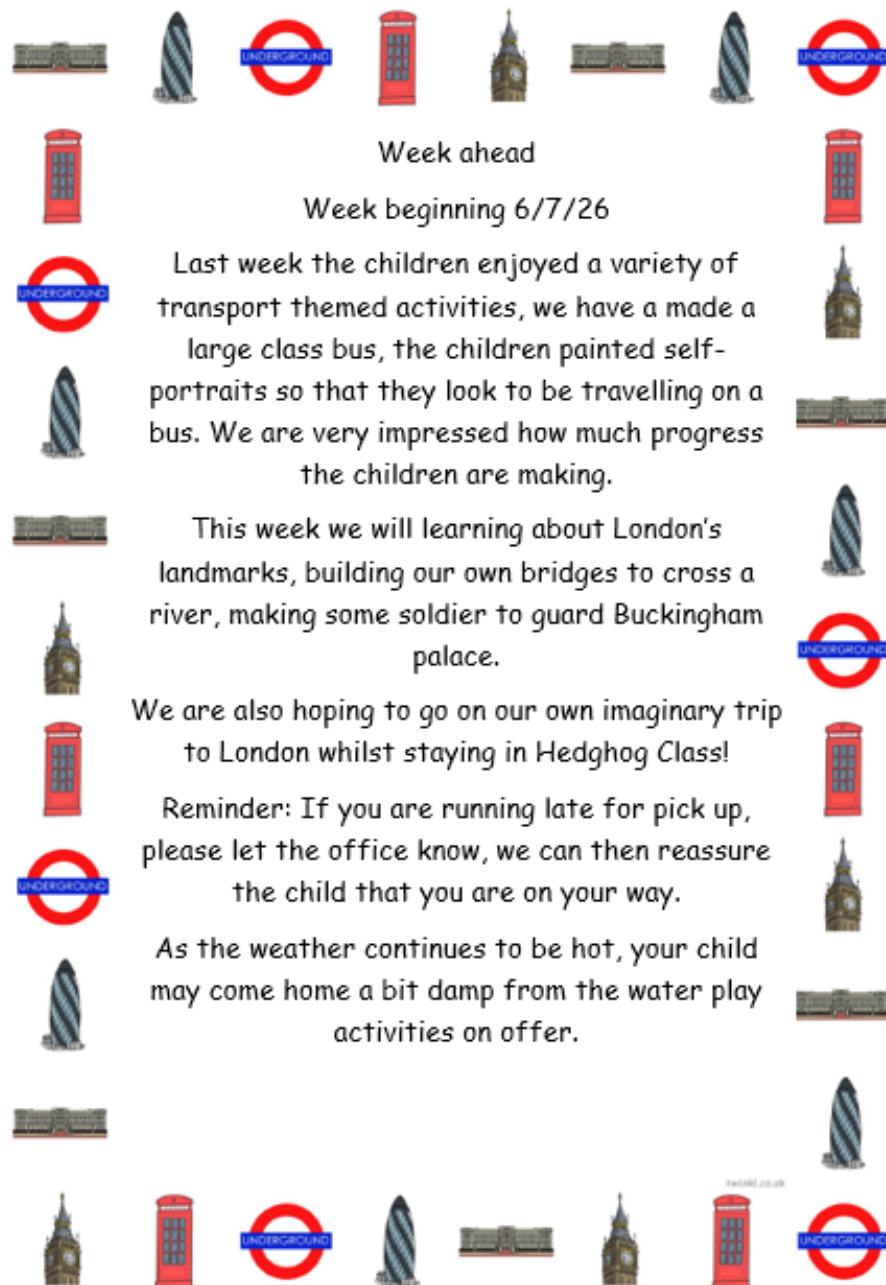




Week ahead
