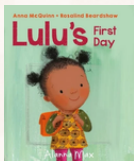


Next week in EYFS, we are continuing to explore our feelings with two new stories!

- In Nursery, we'll be looking at The Kingdom of Colourful Feelings, helping children to identify different emotions, linking them to different colours and thinking about why we feel this way.
- In Reception, we are taking the next step with Ruby's Worry, learning what happens when worries build up and practicing how talking about our feelings helps those big worries feel smaller.
